Dear Scholarship Applicant:

The Shasta Builders' Exchange Scholarship Program has been established as a means to support and secure education for the children who wish to utilize the educational system as a means of obtaining goals they have set for themselves. To date the SBE Community Fund has contributed over \$50,000 to children of Exchange members.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: The Scholarship Program is open to the children of owners (mother/father/legal guardian), key employees of *“regular”* member firms in good standing, children of Shasta Builders' Exchange full-time employees, and any students enrolled in Construction ROP Classes or students attending a trade school. A written recommendation from the Exchange firm's owner or Exchange management must accompany applications from children of key employees or full-time Exchange employees. Students entering or continuing enrollment in a university, college, community college or trade school as a full-time student may make application of scholarship funds.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION: Applications are available in print form at the Shasta Builders' Exchange, or can be downloaded from www.shastabe.com. Applications must be submitted using the “official” form provided by the Exchange. Applications submitted not using the “official” form will be discarded. Applications must be accompanied by: (1) certified transcripts from your High School/College (***please note: first year college applicants must supply H.S. transcripts as well as first semester college transcripts***), (2) High School SAT/ACT scores, and (3) a written recommendation from the firm's owner if the applicant is the child of a key employee or a written recommendation from the Exchange management if the applicant is the child of a full-time Exchange employee. Applicants may resubmit updated applications for up to four years. ***Applications must be received by Friday, March 16, 2012 by 4:00 p.m.***

BASIS OF AWARD: Applicants will be evaluated based on academic performance (GPA, SAT/ACT), school and community extracurricular activities, and work experience. Applicants will be placed into three categories. Those graduating from high school, students currently enrolled in either a two or four-year College, or students currently enrolled in either construction ROP classes or students attending a trade school. The Scholarship Committee will review the applications received and select a group of finalists to undergo personal interviews. ***Please be advised applicants unable to attend the personal interview will be eliminated from the selection process.*** The amount of scholarship money will be determined at the time the recipients are chosen, and will be distributed directly to the recipient upon receiving proof of enrollment as a full-time student to an approved school.
